

- 4. Significant germination of native in places beneath the gorse canopy on the western side, some death of pre-existing gorse plants overwhelmed by thick manuka.
- 5. Marked recovery in toetoe condition and flowering in some areas probably due to removal of cattle and cessation of burning.

- 6. Marked increase in waterfern and bracken in places, often with abundant germination of native shrub/tree species within.
